- Participants may use English for the UN Committees and can be bilingual in the Indian Committees during their speech.
- Portfolios would be allotted on the first come and first serve basis and it's availability.
- There is no limitation on the number of participants from one institute (i.e., any no. of students can participate from one institute).
- Fee once paid is non-refundable.
- There will not be an acceptance of portfolio replacement, once it is allocated.
- If any of the delegate put allegations about the secretariat and the executive board without any solid ground either before committee or after results then their delegation will lead to rejection.
- If any delegate tries to disrupt the flow of the committee or dominate the committee by making chaos and indisciplined activities then the secretariat has the right to take strict actions.
- The organizing committee reserves the right to adopt suitable procedures and changes including time and dates. No grievances with respect to their decision-making will be entertained.
- Participants creating any kind of indiscipline shall be disqualified at the discretion of organizing committee.
- Participants thereby should adhere by the rules and regulations of the event.
